Ni River has implemented a school-wide effective discipline practice called Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). At the start of the school year, your child will be talking about ***being respectful, responsible and productive*** in school. The purpose of PBIS is to teach Ni River students’ expectations that foster positive behavior. Through a common school-wide language, PBIS will allow all students to maximize their achievement while benefiting from a positive classroom and school climate.

Ni River believes students learn better ways of behaving if taught directly and receive positive feedback. As a result, PBIS is designed to acknowledge and celebrate student behavior that meets behavioral expectations. In the event of a student needing additional supports due to behavior concerns, an intervention will occur and a specific behavior plan will be implemented.

Students have been informed of the steps of reprimand when violating the expectations of ***being respectful, responsible and productive***. First Infraction- Lunch consequence, Second Infraction- Communication with parents (Phone or Email), Third Infraction- Conference with parent, Forth Infraction- Referral to administration.
