## How to Find Us?



### **From Spotsylvania Town Center:**

1. Turn left onto VA-3 W (1.0 mi)
2. Turn left onto Salem Church Rd (1.5 mi)
3. Continue onto Leavells Rd. (2.1 mi)
4. Turn right onto VA-208 W/Courthouse Rd (4.2 mi)
5. Turn left onto Courthouse Rd/VA-208 Business (0.7 mi)
6. Turn right onto Brock Rd. (0.2 mi)  
**7409 Brock Rd. is on the right.**

### **From Mary Washington University/Route 1:**

1. Start South onto Jefferson Davis Hwy/US-1 (2.9 mi)
2. Turn right onto VA-208 W/Courthouse Rd (5.9 mi)
3. Turn left onto Courthouse Rd/VA-208 Business (0.7 mi)
4. Turn right onto Brock Rd (0.2 mi)  
**7409 Brock Rd, is on the right.**

### **From Thornburg Exit 118:**

1. Start out going west on Mudd Tavern Rd. Toward Jefferson Davis Hwy/US-1 (0.5 mi)
2. Continue onto Morris Rd (4.5 mi)
3. Turn right onto VA-208 E/Courthouse Rd (4.0 mi)
4. Continue straight onto Brock Rd (0.2 mi)  
**7409 Brock Rd, is on the right.**

**Note: The FREDericksburg Regional Transit provides service to this area, we have 2 stops within walking distance to the center.**

## Do I need to visit the ESOL Welcome Center?

You will register your child at the ESOL Welcome Center if you answer **YES** to ANY of the following questions...

- ❖ The student speaks a language other than English
- ❖ At home the family speaks or understands other languages in addition or instead of English
- ❖ The student is transferring from a country outside the USA
- ❖ The student received English language services in a previous school

## How will the ESOL Welcome Center help me?

- ❖ Create a ParentVUE account
- ❖ Online pre-register your child
- ❖ Complete documentation for home schools
- ❖ Screening and identification of your child's English level
- ❖ Provide information on community resources

## Documents Needed for Registration

- Original birth certificate
- Parent/Guardian ID (with photo)
- Immunization records
- Health records
- Most recent report card
- Official high school transcripts (grades 9-12)
- 2 Proofs of residency documents (Mortgage statement, deed, sales agreement, tax bill, **or** signed lease, **and** one utility bill, electric, water, gas or cable are accepted)

## Time expectation

The amount of time you and your child will spend at the ESOL Welcome Center will vary according to the number of children in the family, the student's grade level and how much time a student takes to complete testing.

In order to be fair to all parents and children, if you arrive late you may have to reschedule your appointment.
