What is Hybrid Learning?

The SCPS School Board decided that beginning with the second nine weeks (October 12), students and teachers can return to the classroom for in-person instruction. Following this model, students will report to school **TWO DAYS** per week for learning. Instruction and assignments will continue to rely heavily on technological engagement and participation. Students will need to bring their laptops to school if they do not have a school-issued chromebook.

Can students remain 100% virtual?

Yes! Students and families have the option to continue learning in the 100% virtual environment. Please reach out to your counselor if you decide this is the best option for your student/family.

What will class time look like?

Instruction may look different from class to class.

Here's an example of 1 possible model of instruction

5 minutes - Tech Check & Sign In

45 minutes - Instruction (Google Slides, Peardeck, Jamboard, videos, readings, etc.)

5-10 minutes - Screen Break & Chat

30 minutes - Questions, Targeted Instruction, Work Completion

IMPORTANT: Students will have a blended opportunity to connect with their teacher online and work independently.

Groups:

Students who have opted to learn in the Hybrid Environment have been placed into either:

Group #1 will participate in face-to-face instruction on Monday (A-day) & Tuesday (B-day) and virtual instruction on Thursday (A-day) & Friday (B-day).

Group #2 will participate in virtual instruction on Monday (A-day) & Tuesday (B-day) and face-to-face instruction on Thursday (A-day) & Friday (B-day).

Group #3 is 100% Virtual Learning
On Wednesdays, all students and teachers will remain 100% virtual.

What are CHHS and Staff doing to keep you safe?

- As mandated by SCPS, masks must be worn at all times EXCEPT when eating.

- Mask breaks will be given as appropriate.
