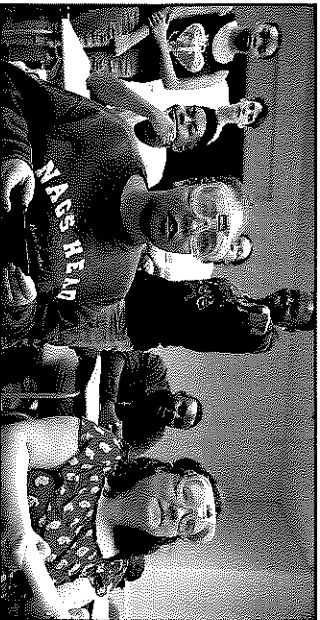
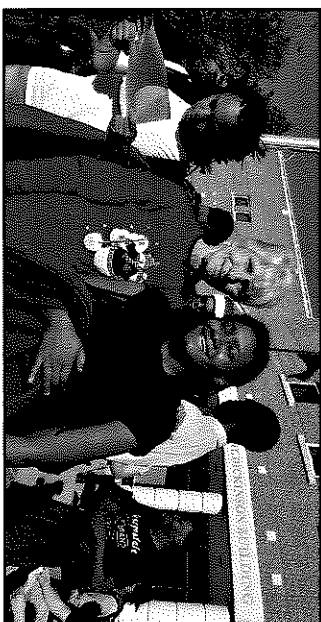
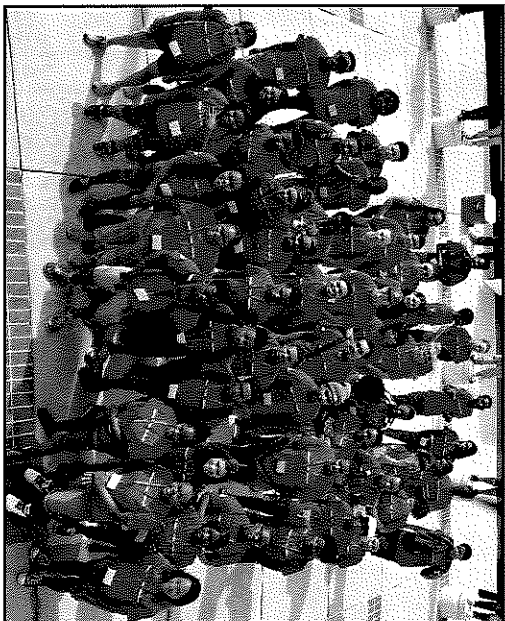

Eligibility for the Gladys Academy program:

- Must be on track to complete 10th grade and be prepared for the junior year
- Must be college ready in their 10th grade of high school as determined by placement scores on the Virginia Placement Test
- Demonstrated financial need
- Be a first-generation college student (neither parent has previously obtained a college degree)
- Be in good disciplinary standing
- Be ready emotionally for the demands of college life
