

February 5, 2021 - Parent/Staff Notice Regarding Instruction Mode

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING INSTRUCTIONAL MODE CHANGE

At the February 3, 2021, School Board Work Session Meeting, the School Board voted to return to in-person for all hybrid students and low incidence students as follows:

Beginning Tuesday, February 9, our students with disabilities in low incidence programs will return to in-person learning. It is important to note that due to the continued impact of COVID-19, parents/guardians of students participating in the low incident programs will need to provide transportation to and from school for your student on Tuesday, February 9. Bus transportation will resume on Thursday, February 11. Parents who are unable to provide transportation on February 9 should contact their child's teacher.

Low incidence programs are as follows:

- Autism Self-Contained and Resource
- Programs for students with Intellectual Disabilities (Mild, Moderate, Severe)
- Programs for students with Developmental Delays
- REACH program
- Behavior Support Programs
- Courthouse/Gateway Academies

Additionally, any students needing internet access may come to the school buildings. At this time, we will not be able to provide transportation.

Beginning Monday, February 22, all hybrid students will return to in-person instruction. Transportation will be provided.

We will continue the Monday-Friday schedule for synchronous and Wednesday asynchronous learning that was used prior to the winter break. Students who were designated as 100% distance-learners will remain in that instructional mode. If you have any questions, please contact your child's school.
