

Title 1 Services

Title 1 supplemental instruction services are funded through State and Federal Grant monies.

Eligibility for these services is based on student need as determined by the student data from schools wide assessment scores (PALS, BAS, SOLs), student performance, and work samples.

Supplemental materials and programs used in Title 1 are research base. Ongoing monitoring is used to assess the effectiveness of the interventions used.

Parents are provided with updated information on their child's performance at regular intervals.

All Title 1 paraprofessionals are under the supervision of the Title 1 teachers and administrators. All programs are regularly monitored and changes are made as needed.

Parents have the right to waive their right to have their child receive Title 1 services.

- Title 1 and classroom teacher reports on your child's progress will be sent home at regular intervals
- Parent-Teacher conferences and parent workshops are offered throughout the year to give YOU the support you need at home

How You support your child...

- Stay in touch with your child's teacher and come to all conferences/ meetings
- Set aside a quiet place and time for homework or home practice on reading/ math
- Make sure your child gets the nutrition and rest they need in order to be in top shape for learning each day.
- Call the school with any questions, concerns, or suggestions. We are here to help!!
